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## EPA ANNOUNCES THE AVAILABILITY OF THE REMOVAL ADMINISTRATIVE RECORD FOR THE SEVEN OUT LLC TANK REMOVAL SITE IN WAYCROSS, GA

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(Atlanta - May 11, 2005) The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) announced today that the Administrative Record for the **Seven Out LLC Tank Removal Site in Waycross, Ware County, Ga.** is available for public review.

The Administrative Record file includes documents that form the basis for selection of the removal action. A removal is a short-term cleanup intended to stabilize a site that poses an imminent and substantial threat to human health or the environment. Documents in the record may include, but are not limited to, preliminary assessment and inspection reports, test results, and the Action Memorandum. All interested persons are encouraged to review and comment on the documents.

At the end of the 30-day comment period, a written response to all pertinent comments will be prepared in a responsiveness summary and placed in the file.

The site is located at 901 Francis Street in Waycross. The past operational history of the site involved the storage and treatment of industrial waste water.
