DISCUSSION/RATIONALE:

ERRB has conducted a partial removal of waste contents from onsite tanks. However, tank sludge remains. Soil contamination exists above PRGs, but not above emergency removal action levels. Soil contamination has not been fully delineated. Sanborn maps show that a machine shop and foundry existed here from 1897. The foundry used coke for fuel, which could partially account for PAHs found in soils. Groundwater and surface water pathways are of concern. In June 2004, approx 4000-5000 gallons of unknown liquids spilled onto soils and may have reached nearby perennial stream. PRPs are expected to cooperate with ERRB and remove the remaining tank sludge and address soil contamination, however an action has not yet been initiated.

SI is needed to further delineate soil contamination source areas, determine where the old foundry building was laid out in relation to present site layout, and determine if there has been a release to groundwater.
